- Always disconnect the scale from the mains power supply before cleaning.


Maintenance


Package Contents

B-450 scale User manual

Keypad & Display



ON/OFF	Turn the scale on or off.
Tare/Zero	Remove unwanted weight from the display prior to weighing
Unit	Toggle between kg and lb readings



Battery Installation



Remove the battery housing cover.





Install a 9V alkaline battery.



Replace the battery cover.

Note: Always ensure the battery cover is fully closed before use.

Operation

Turning Scale On/Off

To turn the scale on, press the **ON/OFF** button. Scale will display **BBBBB** and will then enter active weighing mode.

To turn the scale off, press the **ON/OFF** button.

Zero Operation & Setting

With the scale switched on and nothing on the scale, the display should show zero. If there is nothing on the pan and the display is not zero, press the **TARE/ZERO** button to set zero.

Weighing

To weigh an item, place it in the middle of the platter. When the reading has stabilised, the stable sign will show (see page 5).

If an item is heavier than the scale capacity, the display will show 'Err'.

Using the Tare function

Tare allows the user to zero the weight of a container from the reading shown on the display of the scale, thus giving the true weight of the product being weighed.

Turn on the scale by pressing the **ON/OFF** button.

When

is displayed on the screen, place the empty container on the platter.

Press the **TARE/ZERO** button after the weight stabilises and the stable sign appears on the display.

The display will return to

Place the item that needs to be weighed (without removing the tare object) on the scale. The display will show the Net weight of the item.

To remove the saved tare value, remove the container from the platter and press the **TARE/ZERO** button.

Changing Units

The **UNIT** button allows you to switch from weighing in one unit to another. Simply press the **UNIT** button before or during weighing.

Setting the Auto-off Time

The B-450 has an auto-off time option, which means the scale will switch off automatically after a period of inactivity. The time duration of the auto-off can be selected in the following way:

Turn on the scale using the **ON/OFF** button.

Press and hold **TARE/ZERO** for 3 seconds after the countdown stops and LCD displays zero.

First 'SET' and then 'UNIT' will display.

Press **UNIT** once.

'A_OFF' will display on the screen.

Press **TARE/ZERO**, and the default auto-off time will display on the screen.

Press **UNIT** to select the Auto-off time.

Auto-off time can be set to 120/180/240/300 seconds.

To turn off the auto-off option, press **TARE/ZERO** again. For example, If you want to select 240 seconds, press **TARE/ZERO** when '240 S' displays on the screen. Press **UNIT** twice. The display will show 'End'. Press **TARE/ZERO** to confirm.

Error Messages

ERROR MESSAGE	DESCRIPTION	REMEDY
LobAt	Low battery indication	Replace the battery.
Err	Total load exceeds the capacity of the scale	Reduce the weight on the scale and try again.
ErrL	Counting error. The signal from the loadcell is too low	Please contact Marsden or your supplier.
ErrE	Software fault	Please contact Marsden or your supplier.
